More than 1,000,000 people arrived in Europe by sea in 2015.


In the first 3 months of 2016, the number of sea arrivals to Europe was more than 6x the number of the same time last year.

- Providing shelter and/or beds



All characters start with 10 stamina points.



RULES OF THE GAME

- The objective is to get from Syria to Germany, the country that has accepted the highest number of asylum applications in EU.
- At every stop, you draw a card that tells you
 - where to go next &
 - how that affects your stamina points.
- Some cards give the player the option to make a real-life donation of \$10 or \$20 that will benefit all the players of the game.
